Melvin W. Jackson (#468) received an award for his "Early U.S. Precancels", also for his "China First Day Covers".

OMAHA

At the Omaha Philatelic Society show held in April the USCC Certificate went to J. Stanley Thompson (#439) for "Fancy Cancels on the U.S. 3¢ 1869". The Grand Award and TMPS President's Trophy was won by James H. Wilson (#500) for "Cancellations & Postmarks 1883-87 on #210, 2¢ Brown". Second place and Council Bluffs Award went to Arthur J. Rogers (#438) for ¶Omaha Advertising Covers".

PENINSULAR STATE







