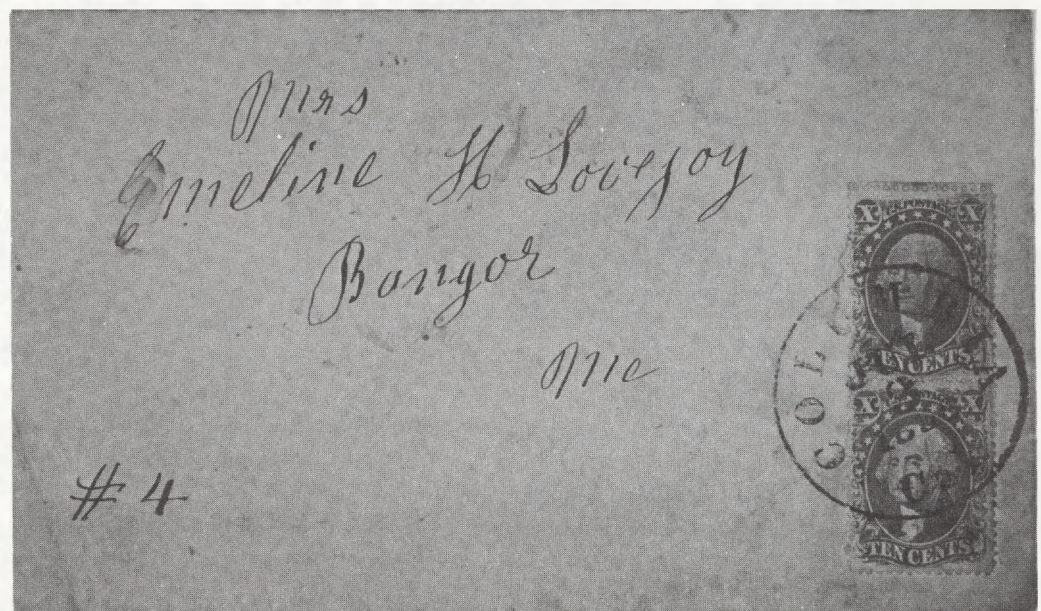
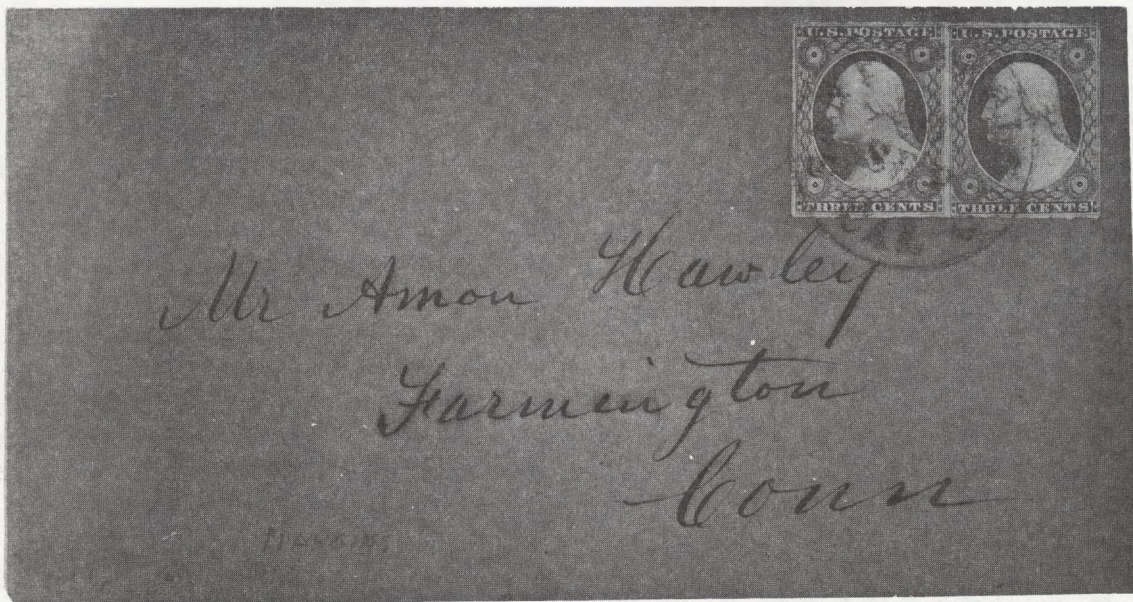

FRONT PAGE

6¢ & 10¢ RATES 1851-63

When gold was discovered in California in 1848 and the rush for riches gained momentum many new problems were created for the U.S. Post Office Dept. Throughout the gold country small communities sprang up around the mining camps almost over night, soon to have their own Post Office, with San Francisco the main point of distribution. In 1851 our first issue of postage stamps (1847) was demonitized, no longer good for postage. A new issue was authorized and new rates for prepaid domestic letters came into being from July 1, 1851 to Apr. 1, 1855 for  $\frac{1}{2}$  oz. not over 3,000 miles, 3¢, over 3,000 miles, 6¢. On Apr. 1, 1855 the 6¢ rate was increased to 10¢, the 3¢ rate remaining unchanged and prepayment was made compulsory. These rates were in force until July 1, 1863 when distance differential was eliminated and the 3¢ rate applied to all parts of the USA.

A collection of covers bearing stamps paying the 6¢ and 10¢ rates to or from East or West during the "Gold Rush" period is an interesting subject of our early U.S. Postal History. Fine examples of the 6¢ and the 10¢ rates are shown on the front page of this issue. Cover #1 is a fine example showing the 6¢ rate during this early period, with a San Francisco Postmark and franked with a 4 margin pair of the 3¢ dull red issue of 1851-5, Type 1. During this period letters were also being sent collect, a 3¢ letter cost 5¢ collect and a 6¢ one cost 10¢. Stampless folded letters were still being extensively used at this time with hand stamped "Paid 3" or "Paid 6¢" etc. Multiples of this 3¢ 1851 issue are extremely scarce particularly on cover. When one does show up it becomes a prized item for a collection such as this. Cover #4 is of special interest, as its aged appearance seems to tell of a long past era of hidden wealth and the human struggle for its possession. Postmarked Columbia, Cal. July 3, 1858 it bears a pair of the 10¢ 1857 issues, types II & III from the same sheet, paying a double 10¢ rate, probably over weight. Columbia, 140 miles east of San Francisco, was situated on the "Mother Lode", a vein 1 mile wide and 100 miles long which produced millions in treasure during the 1850s. It has survived and in 1945 California made the area a state park and today it stands as a living monument to the past where two centuries merge.

### A POSTAL HISTORY OF MISSISSIPPI-STAMPLESS PERIOD 1799-1860

by Bruce C. Oakley, Jr. (#510)

It is hoped that this beautifully bound book will become available sometime late in May or early in June. Mr. Oakley has spent several years in the research necessary for producing an authoritative history of the early postal activities in his state. It embraces the Territorial and Statehood period (1799-1860). Many Townmarks were also in use during the Confederate postal period.

Contents include post office lists, hand-stamped and manuscript townmarks, early and late dates of use of townmarks, establishment and discontinuance dates of postoffices, appointment dates and names of Postmasters, Territorial and Statehood maps, postal routes, numerous illustrations of Covers and other historical facts concerning Mississippi. Townmarks and rate markings are illustrated full size. Over 300 pages of Mississippi Postal History during this period.
